

Chapter, 9 How many Times?

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- ⑧ How many spiders? 3
one spider has 8 legs.
In all, spider legs are 3 times 8
or 8 + 8 + 8 = 24
or 3 × 8 = 24

- ⑨ Do you know this leggy fellow?
This is an octopus.
It lives in the sea.
It also has 8 legs.

So how many legs altogether do 5 octopuses have?
8 + 8 + 8 + 8 + 8 = 40

or 5 times 8 = 40

or 5 × 8 = 40

- ⑩ In the same way, how many bottles are these?

4 times 5 = 20 bottles.

or 4 × 5 = 20

- ⑪ How many eggs?

6 times 5 = 30

or 6 × 5 = 30
