(e) You look tired.

You do not look tired.

(f) I ate too much.

I did not eat too much.

(g) I remember seeing him.

I do not remember seeing him.

(h) The thief ran away.

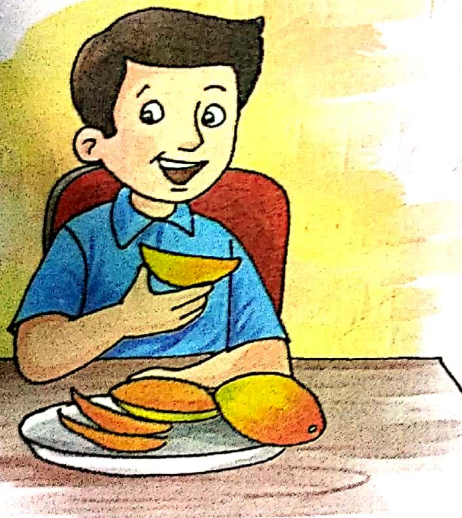
The thief did not run away.
